***When you can't make it to CBS for services CBS can now come to you!***

**We are proud to announce effective Friday, April 20 we began live streaming all Shabbat, holiday services and daily minyan worship services. The streaming technology is a generous gift from the CBS Men's Club and this endeavor has been endorsed by the clergy, Ritual Committee and Board of Trustees.**

**Why are we live streaming? Our CBS clergy as well as the CBS Board of Trustees felt strongly that those that are unable to attend Shabbat and holiday services, minyan and other life cycle events for circumstantial reasons such as being home bound, living in nursing homes, or out of town can still connect to CBS. We also want to serve our "snow bird" community by keeping them connected.**

**"Having fixed cameras on automatic timers on Shabbat and holidays allows us to maintain the sanctity of the day. We feel this is just one more demonstration of Beth Shalom's commitment to inclusiveness and meeting people where they are and enabling their engagement." Rabbi Aaron Melman**

**Streaming will be accessed from our home page on the [CBS Website](#). Simply click the [live streaming link](#) and then pick the service that reads "Live Streaming". You can also watch the service on demand if you can't watch them while they are happening live. Daily minyan services are stored for one week and holidays are stored for one month.**

**The stationary cameras will only focus on the bimah in both the Kamensky Sanctuary and the Feather Beit Midrash. The camera in Rosner Hall will only be used with permission from any guest speaker and or committee that is managing a particular program.**

**By request to Michael Garlin, families that would like to stream a wedding or funeral will receive a password to the stream for the immediate family to share with their loved ones.**
