# June House report from Ray Rokni

**Little Ones –** They are doing very well and requested to amend the contract and add 2 more classrooms for 2022-23.

**FEMA grant Projects – CBS has \$98K in Grant** - CBS has extended contract and deposit with Security 101 group for installation of blue boxes. The cost is in the range of \$25K and will be reimbursed from the grant. The Window film protection project contract and installation are planned for summer. The security protocol document is 3<sup>rd</sup> project and planned for the summer.

**Live streaming & Audio Services - Sound** Planning has replaced "Extron" equipment. They were concerned that it is contributing to the video and audio interruptions. They will be on site monitoring for the next concert.

New CBS Signage: Walters and front entrance – Motion was approved in February by the board for expenditure of up to \$30K for replacement of both CBS signs located on Walters and in front of the building. CBS has signed a contract with PALDO signs and approved the design of the sign which is the CBS Gray color with white letter and logo of CBS and address#. PALDO requested permit from NB. The new NB code will set the sign back several feet. CBS has made a petition to the NB city hall not to move the location or foundation of the sign. CBS has mailed 36 latter to addresses of neighbors that the NB Village has identified for their notification. Notification date is 6/11 and Petition hearing is on 6/27.

**Northbrook Summons!** CBS has installed handicap signs in current locations. project was completed on 6/2 and was planned to be inspected by 6/3 ahead of 6/6 completion deadline.

## **Parsonage**

- Cantor Stoehr residence: Water leak, mold removal and water proofing were completed. We have estimate from Mike Casserly at Integra Residential to do the other basement repairs with drywall replacing the walls and ceiling and install can lighting. Replacing padding of carpet by keeping existing carpet. Cost is \$8300. We have requested electrical permit before starting the work. CBS board was notified in May, and we will bring a motion in June meeting for approval of up to \$10K of expenditure in Cantor residence for fixing the basement.
- Rabbi Chapman residence: CBS is preparing the house for Rabbi Chapman. we have two-week window in June. Removal of carpet on the landing, replacement of a fixture along with general maintenance and interior painting of the house.
