We’ve set a high bar for ourselves at CBS by offering twice-daily *minyan* year-round. And in a community of almost 1000 households, it seems like getting a dozen or so people to show up would be simple. But increasingly often, we lack the ten adults needed to offer the complete liturgy. It’s a perennial question at shuls like ours. How do you encourage more participation at daily *minyan*? Free food, themes, gimmicks? Or maybe we need to change the time, the content, or the marketing... Or maybe we should make *minyan* attendance a requirement for membership? Or maybe we offer a punch-card... After 10 minyans you get to cut in line at *kiddush*! 😊

Or, just maybe, we are asking all the wrong questions.

Rather than finger-wagging to induce guilt or relying on tricks or stunts

(“Shabbat Leftovers Sundays!”), I would rather we get back to basics and explore what *minyan* is really about. (Spoiler alert: It’s not just about saying *kaddish*). Here are some of my thoughts. Amid a global “loneliness epidemic,” our 7:45 am and 7:45 pm *minyan* gatherings offer a burst of community and connection – a built-in way to cut through the isolation of daily life. And, for the many Jews who feel alienated from Jewish practice, *minyan* provides a low-stakes way to reenter the conversation. At least that is what I believe. But clearly, these rationales are not inspiring the masses to participate.

So why *don’t* more people come? Instead of guessing at the answer, we want to collect some data. Please share your thoughts (or lack thereof) regarding our daily *minyan* [here](#). I promise it won’t take you more than a few minutes. Thank you in advance for your honest response. And now, please rise and turn to page 6 in your *siddurim*...

Jewish After School is coming to Congregation Beth Shalom in the fall of 2025.

In 2023, Jewish Kids Groups (JKG), from Atlanta, GA, launched the Jewish After School Accelerator (JASA) to help Jewish organizations across North America start their own Jewish after-school programs for kids in kindergarten through fifth grade. JKG has been serving the Atlanta community for well over a decade. Congregation Beth Shalom is the proud recipient of a \$100,000 matching grant (over a three year period) from JKG. CBS is also the first in the Chicago area to

offer JASA, an amazing Jewish Enrichment Program.

Started in 2023 with a seed grant from The Marcus Foundation and early support from The Zalik Foundation, JKG's JASA program provides synagogues and Jewish organizations across North America with tools, guidance, curriculum, and financial support to launch their own Jewish after-school programs for students in **kindergarten through fifth grade.**

Since its inception, more than **75** synagogues, community centers, day schools, and federations from **45** U.S. cities have applied to participate! CBS is now part of the third cohort and the first in the Chicagoland area to offer this incredible program.

The reason for this program? Modern family life is busy, Jewish families are more diverse than ever, and participation in traditional Jewish supplementary education during the school year continues to decrease. Add rising antisemitism to the mix, and it is more critical than ever for Jewish organizations to pursue convenient, flexible, welcoming, and accessible approaches to youth education that deliver the Jewish connection families want without adding stress to their already full schedules.

Additional information will be coming your way within the next few weeks. CBS members will have the first opportunity to register their children. The program will include transportation from several area schools to CBS followed by a healthy Kosher snack, homework help, and an amazing assortment of activities all with a **Jewish Lens**. You will be able to register your children's attendance anywhere from **two days to five days per week.**

All the leadership at CBS is looking forward to offering a high quality after school Jewish enrichment program for all our members as well as non-members in the Northbrook, Glenview, Deerfield, and potentially other suburbs within a five-mile range of CBS.

A New Ritual for Sharing Matzah

The very first role that I had with Congregation Beth Shalom Sisterhood was “Passover Program Coordinator.” Approximately 100 years ago (but probably more like 10), I took inspiration from the idea that we should all experience the feelings of slavery and liberation during the re-telling of the Passover story. The event that I ended up planning was hearing stories of women in our community who survived oppression, fled unthinkable hardships, and made a new life for themselves. Hearing these inspirational stories can help put us in the mindset for Passover as well as strengthen our empathy for those who are experiencing modern-day slavery and are in need of liberation.

While I was developing this program, the Hebrew Immigrant Aid Society (HIAS) had some incredible resources to bring these stories to our tables. HIAS was founded over one hundred years ago to provide support to Jews fleeing persecution in Eastern Europe. Today, they are working with communities of diverse faiths and backgrounds, all with the same mission of supporting those who are facing violence and oppression, all while being guided by Jewish traditions, texts, and history. It is from those same texts that HIAS is inspired to produce supplements for Passover seders and other traditions that I pulled from all those years ago. I still make a habit to browse the materials they put forth, and I came across a tradition that I will bring to my family this year that I’ll share with all of you.

Many of us are familiar with the part of the seder, at the beginning of the maggid or storytelling section, when we uncover the plate of matzah and declare “this is the bread of our oppression.” Later on in the section, we also learn that “...even before the dough of our ancestors in Egypt had time to rise and become leavened, the Holy One was revealed and redeemed them (from slavery).” It seems that the bread of slavery and oppression is transformed into bread of redemption.

Rabbi Lord Jonathan Sacks z”l teaches that the answer is found when we read more into the text. The line doesn’t stop after “this is the bread of our oppression that our ancestors ate in the land of Egypt” but then the very next sentence says “Let all who are hungry come and eat.” According to Rabbi Sacks, **“what transforms the bread of oppression into the bread of freedom is the willingness to share it with others...”**

This year, the world around us feels unstable, volatile and dangerous, with antisemitism on the rise in the US and heart wrenching news from Israel, it’s easy to feel that we have less freedom and therefore less to give. But in truth, this narrow mindset only serves to inhibit our own compassion and generosity. It may cause us to forget that we were once those who sought safety from oppression.

So how can we use the metaphor matzah’s transformation as a way to rekindle our empathy? Rabbi Sacks suggests that, after distributing the first pieces of matzah around your seder table, and before you say the blessing, you can invite each of your guests to give their piece of matzah to someone else at the table, and in the end, everyone has someone else’s original piece of matzah. Once all of the matzah has been redistributed, you can say together: **Bread that is shared is no longer the bread of oppression.**

It is with this mindset that I invite you to Sisterhood’s Culminating Program on **Tuesday, May 20th**, where we will be celebrating our success this year, and hearing about how women around the world are using their voices to share resources and end oppression everywhere.


