## RABBI CHAPMAN’S CHRONICLES

Rabbi Chapman



Recently, I called a member to wish her a happy 79<sup>th</sup> birthday. “Almost a milestone year!” I said. She replied,

“**Every birthday is a milestone.**” How true. And it got me thinking about Shabbat honors at CBS. Traditionally, we only honored those with “milestone” celebrations with an Aliyah or another Shabbat honor... those celebrating their decennial birthdays or anniversaries (40<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup>, etc.). But why should someone have to wait so long to celebrate with us?

Let’s go even further. How are honors assigned in the first place? You may have noticed the rabbi consulting with the *gabbai* (a.k.a. the “floor manager”) regarding who to call up for various honors during the Torah service, including reading the blessings (aka, “an Aliyah”), opening the Ark, or carrying, lifting, or dressing the Torah. Perhaps you’ve wondered how those individuals are selected. Perhaps you’ve even felt frustrated or overlooked.

Let me peel back the curtain for you – and announce a change in how honors are given. A few honors are reserved for families celebrating *s’machot* – for instance, a Bar or Bat Mitzvah or an *aufruf* (pre-wedding blessing). Additionally, we look for individuals who are commemorating a *yahrzeit* in the coming week – known as a *chiyuv*, or a priority, to receive an honor. Other *chiyuvim* include those leaving for a trip (specifically Israel), and those who have recovered from an illness or injury (when they can recite a special blessing known as *Gomel*). At CBS, as mentioned above, we also honor “milestone” birthdays and anniversaries.

The problem is, we don’t always know who has a *yahrzeit* or a birthday coming up. Furthermore, who are we to say what defines a “milestone” birthday? Or what other commemorations in your life might merit an opportunity to honor you? Participating in the Torah service can be a powerful way to feel close to God, tradition, and community – especially important during those moments of change. We want everyone in our community to feel comforted or celebrated **any time you need it** – not just once every 10 years!

After consulting with the Ritual Committee, we have decided to open things up for a trial period this summer. **If you want to mark any occasion in your life with a Torah service honor on Shabbat, simply email**

[Lifecycles@Bethshalomnb.org](mailto:Lifecycles@Bethshalomnb.org) or call the office with your request. Some

examples of lifecycle moments or transitions you may want to mark with an honor include:

- Retirement
- New home
- Loss of a beloved pet
- New job, promotion, or volunteer role
- Achieving a goal in your Jewish learning
- Child or grandchild’s accomplishment
- Divorce or separation
- A “non-milestone” birthday or anniversary

We may not be able to honor every single request every week, but we will do our best. I look forward to seeing you on the *bima* soon!

## New Program: Special Shabbat Edition of Religious School

This school year we tried something new. Twice during the year, we had class on Shabbat morning instead of on Sunday so students could experience Shabbat instead of just learning about it. On Saturday, October 26<sup>th</sup> our theme was the *Parashah Bereishit* and on Saturday, April 19<sup>th</sup> our theme was Counting the Omer.

On April 19<sup>th</sup> our kindergarten through 7<sup>th</sup> grade students were together for a Passover *Zimriyah* (song session) and a bit of *tefilah*. We then went on the *bimah* in the Kamensky Sanctuary for the beginning of the Torah Service. All of the students led the *Shema* and then our 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> graders continued with *Echad and Gadlu*. We left the main service and divided into two groups.

One group created reusable Omer Counters with a foam board, pipe cleaners, beads and stickers.

The second group stood by the Sea of Reeds and sang "Standing at the Sea" by Peter and Ellen Allard.



The sea parted and the students walked through. They took 33 steps until they came to Lag B'Omer where they shot bows and arrows and made a *kosher l'Pesach* edible bonfire. They could either eat it or take it home.



Students then continued on until they reached step 49 and Mount Sinai. They received a *kosher l'Pesach* chocolate Ten Commandments.



The groups then switched activities and we all ended in the Kamensky Sanctuary with the rest of the congregation. Our older students led *Aleinu* through the end of the service and all received a blessing from Rabbi Chapman and Cantor Stoehr.

What an amazing day! We will have two more *Special Shabbat Editions* of Religious School next year with new themes and activities.

## Lessons in Leadership: Moses and Joshua

*Moses spoke to God, saying, "Let God, Source of the breath of all flesh, appoint someone over the community who shall go out before them and come in before them, and who shall take them out and bring them in, so that God's community may not be like sheep that have no shepherd."*

Numbers 27: 15-17

Recently, I have been thinking a lot about leadership transitions- what 'counts' as successful, what models can make everyone in the transition feel satisfied, and how to support those around the leader. As part of my 'day job,' I consult for companies on how to set up structures to empower leaders and embrace change, and as the President of Congregation Beth Shalom Sisterhood, I have worked hard over the last two years to set all of our leaders up to be successful- now and in the future.

The culmination of my term as President, coming in just a few short weeks, corresponds with several of our weekly Torah portions which discuss the leadership transition of Moses to Joshua. As we know, not only is Moses barred from entering the Land of Israel, but his physical health is also declining, and so Joshua is determined to be the next leader of the Israelites. As we dig into the text about the selection of Joshua as the new leader, a unique pattern appears. There is not one specific time where the transition was announced, but it actually appears to happen three separate, distinct times. In each of these moments, we can learn more about successful leadership transitions.

First, in Parshat Pinchas, we read Joshua's initial appointment. After the incident of Moses striking the rock instead of speaking to it, God informs Moses that he will not lead the people into the Promised Land. Here, **God directly commands Moses** to publicly designate Joshua, setting the stage for his future leadership. God instructs Moses:

"Take Joshua the son of Nun, a man in whom is the spirit, and lay your hand upon him. Cause him to stand before Eleazar the priest and before all the congregation, and commission him in their sight. You shall invest him with some of your authority, that all the congregation of the children of Israel may obey him." (Num 27: 18-21)

Second, in Parshat Vayelech, the Israelites are preparing to cross the Jordan River. Moses addresses the people and reiterates God's promise, **publicly charging Joshua with the responsibility of leading them into the land**. This moment served as a crucial public affirmation that Joshua will serve as a strong and courageous leader.

"Then Moses called Joshua and said to him in the sight of all Israel, 'Be strong and of good courage, for you must bring this people into the land which the Lord has sworn to their fathers to give them, and you shall cause them to inherit it.'" (Deut. 31: 7)

And later in Vayelech, **God speaks directly to Joshua, providing encouragement** for the monumental task in front of him. God appears to Moses and Joshua at the Tent of Meeting, and the text describes God appearing in a pillar of cloud saying:

"And [God] charged Joshua son of Nun: 'Be strong and resolute: for you shall bring the Israelites into the land that I promised them on oath, and I will be with you'" ([Deut. 31:23](#)).

These three instances are the perfect reminder of what is needed for successful leadership transitions: designation from divine authority, a public announcement to the followers, and the leader himself or herself feeling inspired and encouraged by God to take on the task ahead. Rabbi Rachel Sabath Beit-Halachmi, summarizes this by saying, “Not only does a new leader need the authority of his or her predecessor, as well as the acceptance and trust of the people, but a new leader also needs a deep sense of spiritual strength and optimism in order to fully take on the mantel of such leadership at such a profound moment.”

As I prepare to transition leadership of Sisterhood over to the highly capable hands of Frannie Goldwin, as well as a new Sisterhood Board, I hope that we can take the lessons of this transition, that leaders understand the directions of their new positions, that those in the community feel ready to embrace the change, and that everyone feels inspired and encouraged to take on their important and meaningful leadership roles!


