

## Snack Policy

Each class session will have a 10 minute break.

During breaks, students are welcome to bring a snack from home. Vegetables and fruits do not need a *Heksher* (kosher designation on the package). All other items must be dairy or *pareve* and must be in store sealed packages (no Ziplocs) and must have a *Heksher* (kosher designation on the package).

On Tuesdays, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders who come early between 3:30 and 4 p.m. are welcome to buy snacks from the Youth Snack Cart. Snacks range from \$0.25 to \$1. Everything is nut free but some items are made in a facility that processes nuts. There are gluten free items.

On Shabbat Mornings students will have a 10-minute break and snacks will be provided. Please do not bring snacks to services. After services all students are invited to have *Kiddush* lunch with the congregation.
