RABBI CHAPMAN'S CHRONICLES

Rabbi Chapman

*Do not cast me away in my old age!
 When my strength fails, do not abandon
 me. (Psalms 71:9)*

In college, I learned about Heraclitus' metaphor of the river: We can never step in the same river twice, because we are always changing, as is the world around us. This image resonates deeply for us as Jews. We, like rivers, are constantly evolving- not just as individuals, but as a community. Each year brings new faces and somber farewells, yet the continuity of community persists.

As we change, we must honor our past. One way we do this is by cherishing our elders. Change can feel disorienting, but where we are headed is always rooted in what came before.

Since I began here in 2022, CBS has focused renewed energy on families with young children. But this does

not mean we have forgotten our seniors. On Rosh Hashanah, I reaffirmed CBS's commitment to care for and honor our older adults. (Read my complete sermon [here](#) or [watch](#) the video.) As I pointed out, the verse from Psalms 71 that I quoted above is reflected in *Shema Koleinu*, one of the centerpiece of our High Holiday liturgy: "Do not cast us away in our old age, as our strength fails. Do not abandon us." These words – in the plural – remind us that **aging is a shared human experience and communal responsibility.**

At CBS, we've taken steps to ensure our elders feel valued, such as our unparalleled CBS U adult education program, HAZAK events, partnerships with the Jewish Grandparents Network, and preserving legacy *siddur* dedications. Of course, there is always more to be done, and I welcome your ideas and reflections. Rabbi Heschel said, "A test of a people is how it behaves toward the elderly." We at CBS will pass that test.

Let us listen to *all* the voices in our community and together fulfill the Midrash Tanchuma's teaching: *One who greets the face of an elder greets the face of the Divine.*

Lighting the Way

Chanukah is about many things - resilience, memory, the refusal to disappear, and at its heart, it's about light. Not just literal light, but what light symbolizes: presence, purpose, and identity. Light, in Jewish tradition, is more than illumination – it's clarity, it's courage, it's presence. It is the refusal to be extinguished.

This December, as we light our candles each night, I invite us to reflect not only on the historical miracle of Chanukah, but on the miracle of Jewish endurance, of Jewish joy, and of Jewish self-love. Our power as a people has never come from being accepted by the world. It comes from embracing who we are deeply and unapologetically; from loving our people, our heritage, our homeland, and ourselves more deeply and defiantly than the world can hate us.

There's a lot of noise in the world right now. A lot of fear, a lot of distortion, and a lot of hate. Antisemitism is not a Jewish problem. It is a societal illness, a reflection of others' brokenness, not ours. Our task is not to endlessly explain our right to exist, nor to win over hearts closed by bias. Our mission is simpler, and more powerful: To exist. To thrive. To shine.

When we gather to light candles, come to services, show up for each other, and keep Jewish life vibrant, we keep our light alive. Every flame we light, every prayer we say, every mezuzah on a doorpost and Chanukiah in a window declares that we are still here. Proudly. Openly. Joyfully.

This year, as we light our Chanukiah, I hope we do more than remember a miracle. I hope we remember who we are. I hope we reclaim the joy, depth, and beauty of being Jewish, not just in response to fear, but as an act of love. Let's keep lighting the way for ourselves, for one another, and for the generations to come.

Chag Urim Sameach. May this season bring strength, comfort, and renewed hope.



A Tax-Smart Way to Support Beth Shalom

Use Your IRA's Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) to Make a Difference!

If you're age 70½ or older, you can make a **Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)** directly from your IRA to **Congregation Beth Shalom (CBS)** and avoid including it in your taxable income.

Here's how it works:

- A **QCD** counts toward your Required Minimum Distribution (**RMD**).
- It is **not taxable** to you (unlike an **RMD** paid directly to you).
- The maximum annual **QCD** per individual in 2025 is \$108,000.

QCDs are only applicable to traditional IRAs, Simplified Employee Pensions IRAs, and SIMPLE IRAs, and not 401(k) or 403(b) plans.

How to Make a QCD to CBS

1. **Contact your IRA custodian** and request that your **RMD** be sent directly to **CBS**.
2. **Notify Lauri Holmes**, Director of Finance, that a QCD will be coming to **CBS**.
3. The **QCD** must be made by December 31st.

This is a wonderful way to fulfill your RMD requirement, support your congregation, and reduce your taxable income — a true win-win!
