It is hard to believe, but Purim is already around the corner! One of the catchphrases of Purim is “V’hanafoch hu,” which comes directly from the end of the Megillah. It means to turn things upside down - like the Jews reversed their fortunes at the end of the story! On Purim, we try to embody this and turn things on their head.

One of the easiest (and I’d argue most fun) ways to do this is to turn loose our inner child for the day. But how do we do that? How do we connect with the child inside us? You just have to commit. Dress up in a costume with your whole family or friend group. Laugh too loud, make silly animal noises instead of booing during the Megillah reading, experience the wonder of the holiday. Kids don’t ask how to have fun, they just jump in with both feet and do it. You can, too.


Here at Congregation Beth Shalom there will be plenty of opportunities to turn things on their head, jump in

Leadership as a Shared Responsibility

As we begin to settle into a new calendar year, it's natural to take stock of where we've been and to consider the path ahead as a community. It is a time that invites us to think about how we care for one another and how we sustain the work we share.

It is also natural to reflect on leadership; what it means, what it demands, and why it matters. In a Jewish community, leadership is a sacred responsibility grounded in our shared values. It's more than governance and oversight, it's about stewardship of our people, our values, and our future. To lead a synagogue is to help ensure continuity, to safeguard the wellbeing of our members, and to act in ways that reflect the ethical foundations of our tradition.

This understanding shapes how we approach our work together at Congregation Beth Shalom. Lay leaders, clergy, and staff bring different perspectives to the table, but we share a commitment to thoughtful decision-making, clear roles, and respectful dialogue. That approach doesn't eliminate disagreement, but it helps ensure that decisions are made with care and with the long-term health of our congregation in mind.

We listen carefully, especially when perspectives differ; we act thoughtfully, especially when decisions are difficult; and remember that behind every policy or program are people, stories, and relationships. We are called upon to balance the practical needs of today with our obligation to those who came before us and those who will come after.

This shared leadership is one of CBS's strengths. From those who serve in formal roles to those who quietly step up when help is needed, our community benefits from a wide circle of committed members who care deeply about our congregation and are willing to give their time, thought, and energy to its wellbeing.

As we move further into this year, my hope is that we continue to lead, and to follow, with intention, humility, and a deep sense of responsibility to one another. May our actions reflect not only what needs to be done, but who we aspire to be as a Jewish community.

Wishing you a year filled with intention and meaning.

CANTOR'S NOTES

Cantor Stoehr



This historic image is one of a death doula, a trained and nurturing individual who is assisting a person who is in the process of dying (much akin to a birth doula who helps someone deliver their baby). The recent practice of the death doula began in the late 1900's and early 2000's. The modern death doula may be compared, in some ways, to a hospice caregiver of today.

As clergy, cantors and rabbis engage in a segment of this spiritual and compassionate act in many people's lives. We take part in counseling the individuals, and families, in the rites of passage, and the Jewish laws which direct us in the limits of what we can or cannot do for someone.

Clergy also participate in bedside ceremonies called Vidui, which is a deeply sacred moment of farewell. It is composed of ancient prayers, beautiful poetry and song. It allows the individual to pronounce their flaws in life to God via traditional prayers and personal whispers of one's conscience. This ritual is similarly performed every Yom Kippur when we stand and confess our sins and shortcomings. At the end of Yom Kippur, just prior to when the sound of the shofar reverberates throughout the halls, we chant Sh'ma, Baruch Shem and Adonai Hu, just as one does during the Vidui at the close of one's life.

CBS is proud of the Chevre Kaddishe which has served our community for close to 25 years. We have helped to prepare someone for the final stages of burial for more than 225 individuals. This experience is life-changing for those on the Tahara teams.

On **Tuesday, February 24** at 6:30 pm, the Chevre Kaddishe will be holding a program to honor our membership who have given so many hours to this mitzvah. It aligns with the Hebrew date of Adar 7, the date of when Moses is said to have been born and the date of his yahrzeit. The Torah teaches us that God buried Moses and we, the Chevre Kaddishe, are following in God's example of compassion and respect. We will be hosting Catherine Durkin Robinson, who is a professional death doula, and she will be sharing some very captivating details about her career. If you wish to attend and honor your fellow CBS members, and hear about this fascinating role as a doula, you are welcomed to attend.


