Celebrating Torah – and Our Torah Readers – this Shavuot

Shavuot carries the unfortunate nickname, “the forgotten festival.” Despite being one of the five primary holidays outlined in the Torah, Shavuot lacks the gravitas of Yom Kippur, the richness of Pesach, or the sensory delights of Sukkot. Of course, Shavuot has always been celebrated at CBS, but in the last few years, it has been given a renaissance.

Last year, we welcomed more than 150 people for our “Spring into Summer Shavuot Dinner,” many of whom stayed for learning sessions late into the night at our Tikkun L’eyl Shavuot.

This year, we are planning something even more special. Shavuot commemorates the Jewish people receiving Torah at Mount Sinai (giving the festival its moniker *Zman Matan Torateinu* – the time of the giving our Torah). So, this year, we are creating a **Shavuot celebration all about Torah – in all its forms**. The evening will begin with a Torah-themed scavenger hunt for our families with children. Later, following our (now annual!) festive dinner, we invite you to join an expanded Tikkun L’eyl, during which we will dive into some of the many traditions surrounding Torah chanting.

Then, on the morning of the second day of Shavuot, we will honor our beloved CBS Torah readers (a.k.a. the “Yad Squad”). The Yad Squad is one of CBS’s greatest treasures. Many synagogues rely on professional Torah readers or clergy for the lion’s share of chanting. But at CBS, we have dozens of skilled and committed volunteer Torah readers, from teenagers to nonagenarians. What a special thrill it is when a new Torah reader steps up to the Shulchan (table) for the first time. We also love seeing the siblings, parents, and grandparents of a B’nai Mitzvah add honor to the day by chanting Torah. (Almost all our readers have benefited from the expert tutelage of our own **Randi Simon** and **Susan Stoehr**.) Our Torah readers deserve our praise, and this Shavuot we will share that appreciation.

Shavuot will be observed this year from May 21-23. Join us to make sure the forgotten festival is never forgotten again!

THE MEANING OF THE HOLIDAY OF SHAVUOT

Shavuot celebrates the gift of Torah. After the festival of Pesach we count the Omer for seven weeks until we arrive at 6 Sivan. In doing so we relive two journeys. The first is the exodus from Egypt, making our way, miracle by miracle, to Mount Sinai. And the second is the seasonal journey from the spring harvest to the summer harvest. In Temple times, Shavuot was marked by bringing harvest gifts (bikkurim) to God, expressing gratitude for having settled in the Promised Land and being able to draw sustenance from it. Today we mark it by recalling when God gave us the Torah and immersing ourselves in it. This dual meaning of Shavuot—as a celebration of harvest and a celebration of the giving of the Torah—expresses a direct connection between Torah and abundance. This connection encourages us to experience Torah as a bountiful harvest—evoking a sense of satiation, fulfillment, and overflowing gratitude. It teaches us that, through immersing in Torah, we are nourished.

A Conversation with Kevin

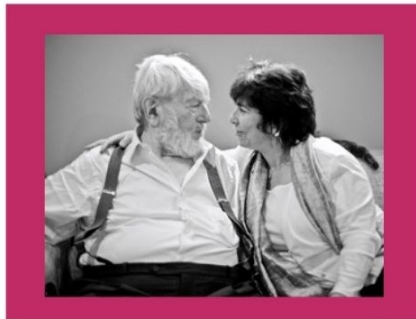
