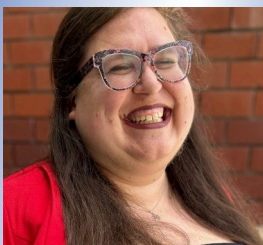

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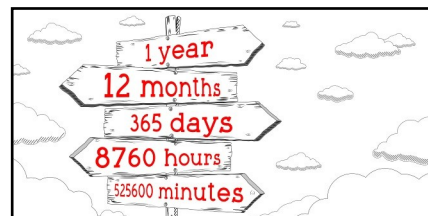

"525,600 minutes. How do you measure a year?" the musical *Rent* famously asks us. There are so many ways that I could measure my first year here at CBS. As someone who loves numbers, my first instinct is towards that. I've had the pleasure of working with 19 B'nai Mitzvah students, teaching 21 adult education class sessions, and spending approximately 96 mornings at minyan. Together we've celebrated a full year on the Jewish calendar, been at four spectacular shul-wide holiday programs, and celebrated hundreds of years' worth of life and love through birthday and anniversary *Selahbrates*. Rabbi Bubis and I, along with our davening team of 10, have co-led seven *Ruach* Shabbat Friday nights, and welcomed more than 80 people to a community Shabbat dinner. As much as I love numbers, though, these statistics cannot properly convey what an incredible journey and blessing this year has been.

The best parts of synagogue life cannot be measured. Numbers don't speak to the incredible "AHA" moment when something clicks for one of our lifelong learners in a CBSU class. There is no way to quantify the joy of welcoming all the kids onto the bimah every week on Shabbat morning, seeing the kids grow and meeting the newest additions. And while I could tell you how many coffee dates I have been on this year, there is absolutely no statistic that could capture the blessing it is to get to meet so many of you, to be welcomed into your lives, and to get to know you in such a holy and precious way.

Whether measuring the year by the number or reflecting on the ineffable moments along the way, this year has been so full. With as much as it has held, though, it is still only a beginning. This year has been a gift, and I cannot wait to see what the next 525,600 minutes have in store!

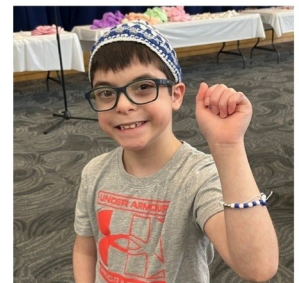
What can you do to sustain this momentum?

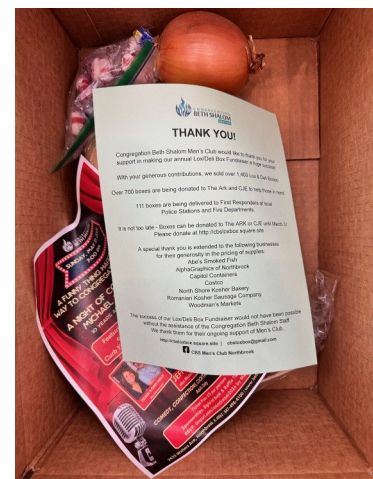
