ANNOUNCING CBS'S "SHALOM L'TZIYON" PODCAST

Recently, I attended a gala with the Consulate General of Israel to the Midwest, celebrating both Israel's 78th birthday and the United States' 250th. In his remarks, Consul General Elad Strohmayr (who recently spoke at CBS) struck an upbeat, hopeful tone as he recognized the many faith, business, and civic leaders from across the Midwest in attendance. A high-octane video showcased the vibrant partnership between Chicago and Israel in the areas of tech, healthcare, and tourism. If you ignored the intense security measures in the event hall, it seemed for a moment like everything was "normal."

The following day, in New York City, several candidates with extreme views opposing Israel won their primaries, almost assuring their election to Congress or state legislature. In many of these races, support for Israel (or lack thereof) was the dominant difference between two similar candidates. One of my mentors, a respected Upper West Side rabbi, lost her primary for State Assembly despite having spent two decades organizing for progressive causes.

Many observers speculated that the determining factor in that race was her support for Israel, in contrast to her opponent.

These two back-to-back moments illustrate our precarious position today as American Jews who support Israel. We are in a split-screen reality: simultaneously defiant and vulnerable, proud and frightened. We need more friends, and yet polarization (across the spectrum) threatens to snuff out meaningful discourse.

As you might know by now, I am not really a "Facebook rabbi." I don't go for sound bites or memes (no disrespect to those who do!). I prefer deeper dialogue, especially about important issues. To that end, I am excited to announce **Shalom L'Tziyon, CBS's new Israel-focused podcast**. The name references our synagogue, but also our eternal hope that peace will come to the land of Zion. In each episode, I will interview Israelis about their life and work, their experience over the last few years, and what they hope for in the future, along with questions from the community.

Watch for new episodes to "drop" at the end of each month on our *Shalom L'Tziyon* page on the CBS website. (coming soon). And if you have ideas for guests, please share them!

I look forward to offering this new opportunity for our community to engage with Israel. *Am Yisrael Chai!*

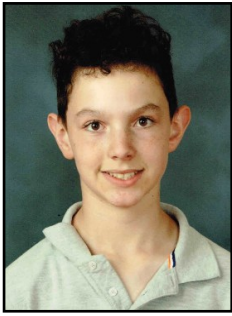

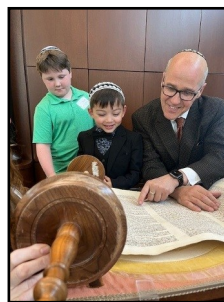
